- I. Election of Co-Chairs (3 minutes)
 - Blaizen was elected the chair and Declan the vice-chair of the Youth Outreach Committee by group consensus.
- II. Discussion of Science Fair on 3/16/19 (97 minutes)
 - Ideas were proposed to include social media, such as instagram, snapchat, discord, facebook, and twitter, as well as including the vagp site because of the lack of a hrgp site, and the next general membership meeting. Ideas to include different energy sources, how to guides for making environmentally friendly contraptions at home, science projects, and how to be involved politically locally were proposed. It was decided unanimously to try to avoid being too political, and an idea was proposed on if we could table at the event, and promote simple ways to improve the environment, such as composting, where flyers could be handed out listing the simple ways to improve the environment, with the social media on the bottom of the flyer. It was also decided that if approved, a poster or two would be created and placed with the table to show details on the pipeline and environmental effects in general in Hampton Roads.
- III. Additional Ideas (22 minutes)
 - Additional ideas were proposed such as a youth blog for how-to guides on the hrgp site when it's created, non-political social gatherings, such as a soccer game, that would start sometime in April, forming a local Zero Hour chapter, and using the Hampton Roads Discord to advertise events.
